- Shetland's redesigned bus service -

SHETLAND'S bus network is in the process of being re-designed to make it more efficient and cost effective, while providing the public transport that local people require.

The team at Shetland's transport partnership ZetTrans has spent the past two years consulting with local communities to find out what kind of service they are looking for.

Now they have come up with a redesigned timetable and are once again going out to the public to see what they think of it.

The new proposals are designed to remove any inequalities that may exist in the current service, and to make it easier for people to access work opportunities, education, health care and local shops.

It is imperative that we design a satisfactory bus service before it goes out to tender in November.

We want to make sure that any gaps are filled and any waste is removed so that we can have the best service possible within the available budget.

Transport staff are visiting communities the length and breadth of Shetland during September to give people the opportunity to examine and discuss the proposals (details below).
