I would like to be a MSYP because I feel I could really make a difference in Shetland. Being a member of Scottish Youth Parliament presents lots of opportunities. I believe I can take these opportunities and resolve the issues presented by the young people of Shetland.

Some of the issues that matter most to me are the fact that people in mainland Scotland have more subject choice and therefore have more opportunity, I want to campaign for getting young people the same opportunities with subjects in Shetland as the mainland. Even people on the smaller islands of Shetland, such as Whalsay and Unst don't have as much opportunity as students on mainland Shetland, I feel this is unfair and needs to be addressed. Teens in Shetland have gotten in trouble for misuse of social media; I believe this is partly because they are not properly educated on how to use it safely and for the right purposes. I want to raise awareness on this issue in schools around Shetland.

Transport is a big issue in Shetland, things have been getting better but I still feel there isn't enough buses for young people in the more rural parts of Shetland, this could be solved by speaking and discussing with the bus companies, many young people in Shetland use buses on a daily bases as their only means of transport. I feel there aren't enough buses to get around, especially to the more rural areas of Shetland. I would like to try and change this and improve this and if I'm elected I will campaign to do so. If elected I would speak with and organise a meeting with ZETRANS Shetland and speak on this issue.

As an elected MSYP I will reach out to young people and ensure they are represented as I would want to be represented. These ways will include speaking in schools and colleges. Connecting with young people from all areas in Shetland and ensure their voices are heard and represented!

I think Shetland needs a SYP member like me because I am confident and I will listen to anyone who wants to be heard, I will speak on the issues the young people have presented to me.
