I think there is an issue with young people waiting for buses. From personal experience, getting the 11pm bus to Weisdale is a nightmare. The latest bus before 11pm is 5.15. there is now nowhere in Lerwick to wait for buses, particularly in bad weather, with venues not being very welcoming to young people at this time of night.

As well as starting my own Scottish Youth Parliament social media pages, I will also make myself approachable to all students across Shetland and host surveys and Twitter poll's in order to ensure that the young people in Shetland are as best represented as possible. I aim to consult with young people in Shetland by working with pupil councils across Shetland to ensure their voices can be heard.
