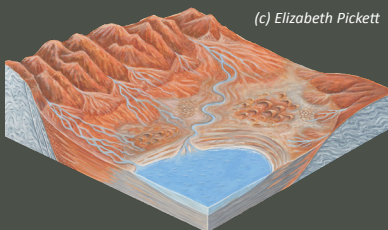
Shetland Geological Society presents:

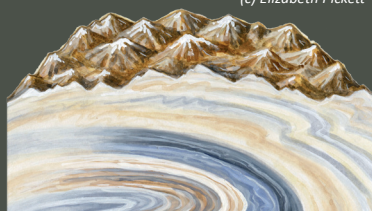
